Things to be aware of:

- A student must have finished the fall semester with at least a 45% to be eligible for a class.
- Transportation will not be provided. TARC tickets may be available while supplies last.
- Student must complete a minimum of sixty hours in class in order to receive a ½ credit. There will be no extensions or opportunities to do make-up work.

2020 Spring Extended School Services – Student Expectations Contract

- You must work on tasks as assigned by the teacher for 120 minutes each day. No exceptions. The reason for being in the program is to earn an academic credit. Student who do not apply themselves will be asked to leave and/or removed from the program.
- Students will be expected to follow all school and classroom rules.
- The Eastern High School Dress Code and Code of Conduct policies will be enforced.
- Referrals to the Assistant Principals' Office may result in dismissal from the program.
- Only one (excused or unexcused) absence and one tardy (excused or unexcused) will be allowed. The second, of either, will result in dismissal from the program.
- You must be on time. Sessions start at 2:30 and end at 4:30pm. You will be admitted late only once (this includes returning from any breaks). The second tardy will result in dismissal from the program.
- The course session ends at 4:30pm. Do not ask to be excused earlier. Any early dismissal (excused or unexcused) will be handled the same as a tardy.
- You must bring materials. This may include a tablet, books, pencil, paper, and all other materials assigned by the teacher. The teacher will communicate requirements on the first day of ESS.
- Allowing food or drink will be at the discretion of the teacher/instructor.
